Scope:

The first Algerian summer school on biometrics ASSB'2010; organized by the Systems Architectures and Multimedia Laboratory of the Centre of Development of Advanced Technologies under the patronage of the General Directorate for Scientific Research and Technological Development (DGRSDT); aims to provide clear and in-depth summary of the state-of-the-art research in biometrics. The lectures will be given by outstanding experts in the field, and will cover both theoretical and practical aspects of biometrics. The school is especially aimed to provide a stimulating space for young researchers and Ph.D. students, and also to provide a forum for people from government, commercial, and other institutions to hear and discuss the recent advances in the area of biometrics and related technologies. The participants will benefit from direct interaction and discussions with world leaders in biometrics.

The school will consist of lectures given by 10 outstanding experts in the field of biometrics, and poster sessions in which PhD students will present their work and discuss their research topics with internationally acknowledged researchers in the field as well as with peer PhD students.
